#### FROM WHERE I SIT MARCH 2013

On December 9, 1914, Edison Industries was burned to the ground. The loss was devastating, over \$2 Million Dollars, not to mention all of the priceless work and notes of Thomas Alva Edison! The company was only insured for \$238. The buildings were constructed out of concrete, and it was thought at the time that they were therefore fireproof. At the age of sixty-seven, Edison watched as his entire life's work went up in flames.

By morning the firefighters had finally brought the inferno under control. And as Edison surveyed the scene, with all of his charred dreams and crushed hopes laying there before him, he said, "There is great value in disaster. All of our mistakes are burned up. Thank God we can start anew".

How often do we look at hardships as if they were some type of punishment, rather than as a vehicle to help us grow? You've all heard the analogy of a lump of coal needing extreme heat and pressure in order to become a beautiful diamond. You may have even heard that fire can either purify, and refine. Or, it can utterly destroy! Well Lent is a good time to "turn up the heat".

On the first Sunday of March the Lectionary brings us Jesus' parable of the non-productive fig tree. He tells it in response to some folks asking about a couple of tragic events. In the lesson the caregiver digs around the roots, totally upsetting the tree. And then he pours on the manure! Out of Grace, the fig tree is "disturbed" in order that it might produce fruit. It isn't coddled or babied, it is intentionally shaken! It sort of makes you think, doesn't it? Maybe the boat-rocking in my life is there to make me a better sailor? And maybe that

gale-force wind that is threatening to knock me down is really there to help my kite to soar? What do you think?




